AMENDMENT TO PRIZE RULES

The Australian Institute of Architects (South Australian Chapter) Prizes

Whereas the Australian Institute of Architects (South Australian Chapter) has agreed to provide annual prizes of the total value of \$1000 in the School of Architecture and Built Environment, the following rules are hereby made:

1. The prizes shall be called "The Australian Institute of Architects (South Australian Chapter) Prizes".
2. (a) Three prizes shall be awarded by the Executive Dean of the Faculty in the amount of \$100 each, for the following groups of courses in the Bachelor of Architectural Design.

(i) Level I Bachelor of Architectural Design compulsory courses.

Design Studio 1 (DESST 1503) / History Theory 1 (DESST 1505) / Representation 1 (DESST 1504) / Design Studio 2 (DESST 1506) / Environment 1 (DESST 1508) and Construction 1 (DESST 1507)

(ii) Level II Bachelor of Architectural Design compulsory courses.

Design Studio 3 (DESST 2516) / Environment 2 (DESST 2517) / Construction 2 (DESST 2518) / Design Studio 4 (DESST 2519) / History Theory 2 (DESST 2521) / Representation 2 (DESST 2520)

(iii) Level III Bachelor of Architectural Design compulsory courses

Design Studio 5 (DESST 3513) / Construction 3 (DESST 3514) / Representation 3 (DESST 3515) / Design Studio 6 (DESST 3516) / History Theory 3 (DESST 3518) / Environment 3 (DESST 3517)

In each group of courses the prize shall be awarded to the student enrolled in the program for the degree of Bachelor of Architectural Design who, in the annual assessment, obtains the highest aggregate of results in that group of courses.

- (b) Two prizes shall be awarded by the Executive Dean of the Faculty, in the amount of \$200 each, for the following groups of courses, or course in the Master of Architecture:

(i) **ARCH 7032 Studio Cultures: Architecture (M) and ARCH 7034 Studio: Urbanism (M)**

(ii) **ARCH 7040 Studio: Architecture (M)**

- (c) One prize shall be awarded by the Executive Dean of the Faculty, in the amount of \$300 each, for a course in the final semester of the Master of Architecture:


(iii) **ARCH 7043 Final Architecture Project (M)**

In each group of courses, or course, the prize shall be awarded to the student enrolled in the Master of Architecture or the 'architecture stream' of the Master of Architecture/ Master of Landscape Architecture program who, in the annual assessment obtains the best result in that group of courses, or course.

- (d) No award of a prize shall be made if no candidate is considered by the School to be of sufficient merit.

3. Where two or more candidates are of equal merit, the relevant prize(s) shall be shared equally in any of the above categories.

4. These rules may be varied by agreement between the University and the Australian Institute of Architects (South Australian Chapter).
