## The Walter Brooke Prize for Design

### Prize Rules

#### Establishment

This Prize has been established by a donation to the University from Walter Brooke and Associates Pty Ltd, in recognition of John Walter's contribution to the Architectural profession and for his close connection to the University of Adelaide.

#### Value

Walter Brooke and Associates will award \$700.00 per year plus 6 weeks unpaid internship to the recipient(s). This prize will be awarded each year for 5 years (2019 to 2024), or until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the donor.

#### Eligibility

The prize is awarded by the University annually to a full-time student(s) completing their degree of Masters of Architecture or the Master of Architecture / Master of Landscape Architecture.

#### Selection of Candidate

The prize shall be awarded to the student who obtained the highest marks in the core course: ARCH 7032 Studio Cultures: Architecture.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize may be shared equally.
