AMENDMENT TO PRIZE RULES

TCL Landscape Architecture Prize

Intent

The TCL Landscape Architecture prize is intended to recognise students who achieve the highest quality design in the final year of the Masters of Landscape Architecture program.

Conditions

Whereas Kevin Taylor and Kate Cullity of Taylor Cullity Lethlean (nominal Taylor Cullity Lethlean below), have agreed to provide for an annual prize of \$1000 to the final year student studying for the Masters of Landscape Architecture in the School of Architecture and Built Environment at the University of Adelaide, the following rules are hereby made:

1. There shall be an annual prize called "TCL Landscape Architecture Prize" for the next five (5) years, commencing in 2010.
2. The prize shall be \$1000 per annum, unless otherwise determined by the School of Architecture and Built Environment in consultation with Taylor Cullity Lethlean.
3. The prize shall be awarded annually to the final year student studying full time in the Masters of Landscape Architecture program. This evaluation will be based on the assessment of the final year project by the adjudicators. The assessment of submissions in the course "**LARCH 7033 Final Landscape Architecture Project (M)**" will nominate a candidate for the award for consideration by Taylor Cullity Lethlean.
4. The award shall be announced on the night of the Final Year Exhibition.
5. The Adjudicator Panel will comprise the Coordinator and assisting Staff of the Final Year project, in consultation with Taylor Cullity Lethlean, with their recommendation to be endorsed by the Head of School.
6. The Adjudicator Panel shall nominate one candidate only.
7. These rules may be varied by agreement between the University and Taylor Cullity Lethlean but the title and general purpose of the Prize shall not be changed.
