
The Nova Systems Prize for Aerospace Engineering

PRIZE RULES

Establishment

This Prize has been established by the University as a result of a contribution by Nova Systems, which is an organisation that provides the Australian Defence Force, Government agencies and Industry with independent and professional Test and Evaluation and System Engineering services. Nova Systems supports the University with the development of engineers via a number of awards and judging support for the final year project program.

In support of the prize Nova Systems shall provide to the University as a result of a pledge request, an annual amount equivalent to \$500.00 (GST free).

Value

The value of the Prize will be \$500.00 per year for 5 years from 2016, until otherwise determined by the University after discussions with the contributor.

In addition, the successful candidate will also be awarded an inscribed medal, supplied by Nova Systems.

Eligibility

The prize will be awarded annually by the University to eligible students who have completed Level IV of the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Mechanical and Aerospace) degree program or associated double degrees with a Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Mechanical and Aerospace) component.

Selection of Candidate

The Head of School of Mechanical Engineering will award the prize to the Bachelor of Engineering (Honours) (Mechanical and Aerospace) student with the highest Honours classification as determined by the mark.

If there is no candidate of sufficient merit in a given year then the prize will not be awarded in that year and the money will be used in subsequent years.

If there is more than one candidate of equal merit, then the prize shall be shared equally.

Variations

The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the original objectives of the prize.
